

Southampton Common: Hawthorns Wildlife Centre/Café

Proposed short term improvements to setting:

1. Clear vegetation either side of entrance to open up visibility on approaches from both directions on Bellemoor-Northlands path and return to grass
2. Remove portacabin and associated storage
3. Create enlarged patio area (gravel where no existing tarmac)/more tables at front (out of shade) for dog owners in particular
4. Tidy up generally vegetation on and around patios, front and back
5. Tidy up outside education room French doors and paint doors to match rest of building



A. SCC to:

1. Clear portacabin etc.; restore surface exposed suitable for patio
2. Investigate/install presentable see-through boundary treatment
3. Remove with chainsaw stems too large for hand-tools within green zones
4. Stump grind as necessary areas cleared by volunteers
5. Maintain those areas as amenity grass thereafter

B. SCF volunteers to

















1. Cut remaining vegetation by hand within green zones
2. Clear cuttings to suitable woodland pile

Timing TBA – target: October- December 2017 for A1-3 and B1-2

January-March 2018 for stump-grinding/grass regeneration

NB: areas being cleared are shown as amenity grass on still extant 1992 Management Plan (see overleaf), having since become overgrown, contrary to plan.
